Who:

We are a grassroots podcast team comprising of five individuals from around Ireland with no party affiliation or backing from anyone. We run "Shared Ireland" in our own time and share all the tasks required, which include contacting prospective guests, scheduling interview dates, researching our interviewees, formulating questions and traveling to various parts of the country to interview our guests. In addition to this, our team are involved in post-production editing, media creation and social media promotion.

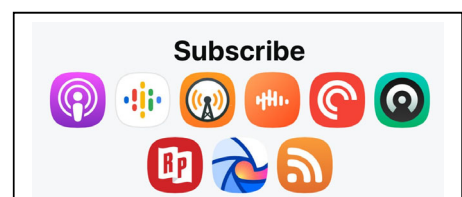
When?

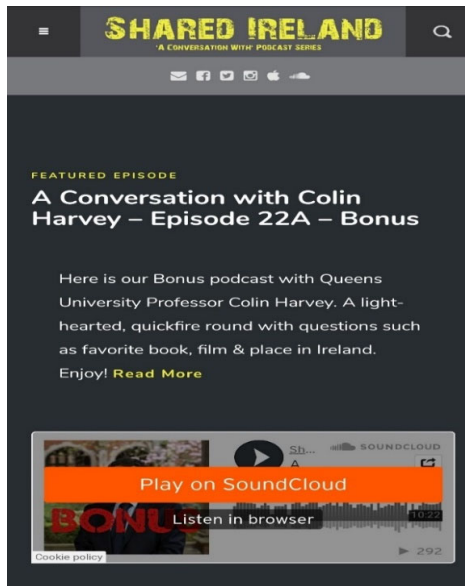

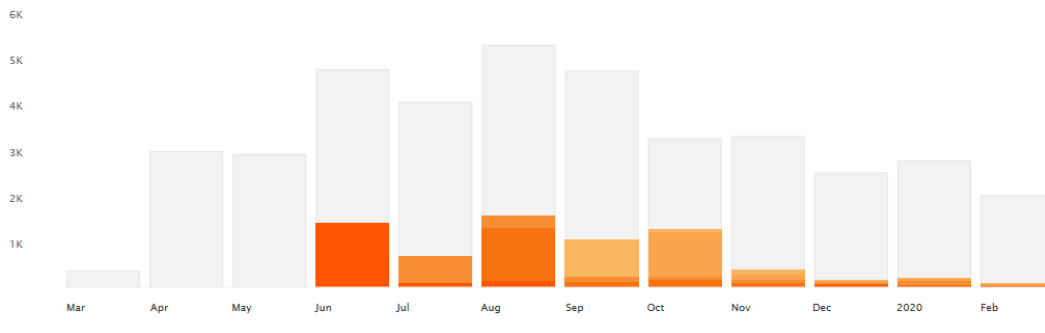
